



What is WPSA?

WPSA is the Warwick Preparatory School Association. It is run by a committee of elected parents and teachers with the aim to provide the environment and activities for the children and parents to develop friendships outside of the school curriculum.

WPSA has Charity status and the key roles within the committee are also trustees alongside the Head of Warwick Prep School.

Parents or Guardians of pupils at Warwick Prep School are automatically members of WPSA on joining the school.

What does WPSA do?

WPSA organises fun events for the children and parents throughout the year. Whilst our focus is on providing fun activities for the children outside of the school timetable, we also organise activities for the parents that have proven to be very popular and well supported.

Type of events include; Macmillan Coffee Morning, Quiz Night, Summer Fun Day, Christmas Fair, Film Night (Lower School), Disco (Upper and Middle School), Easter Egg Hunt (Lower School including Nutkins), Joint Summer Ball with KHAPS (King's High Parent's Association). We also run the Uniform Shop.

As WPSA is not primarily about fundraising the activities are generally self-funded, however any revenue generated is split between charities and reinvestment into the school for the benefit of the children via a bidding process for children and teachers.

Successful bids have included the provision of display boards, plants, clocks, outside games and equipment, wet play activities, resources for Earth Day, books, musical instruments and funding for merit and house badges.
