For most children, school life at Warwick Prep begins in our warm, welcoming and secure **Nursery**, where dedicated Early Years teaching staff help each child to feel happy, confident and able to achieve as they take their first tentative steps into the exciting world of learning. By providing a carefully balanced programme of structured activities, alongside learning through discovery and play, the children grow in confidence while developing core skills and independence.

Our **Reception** classes are located in the main school buildings. Each class has a fully qualified teacher and teaching assistant, allowing us to closely support each child with their learning. Pupils are encouraged to progress at their own pace with teachers gently challenging and motivating the children, placing a strong emphasis on care for one another. Communication between home and school is key to us and we welcome parents' input into their child's development profile.

In **Years 1 and 2** we build on the enjoyment and enthusiasm for learning fostered in the Early Years. Pupils spend much of the day with their class teacher and full-time assistant, but also have the benefit of subject specialists in Music, French, Computing and Games lessons.

We retain the best elements of traditional teaching with an emphasis on literacy and numeracy skills, and this is strongly supported by a full range of subjects and activities which are designed to broaden horizons and develop adaptable, resourceful and independent learners. As a result of such a nurturing and educationally fertile environment, pupils typically perform well above the national average by the end of Key Stage One.

Boys leave us at this point with the majority moving onto Warwick Junior School on the adjoining campus.



With excellent indoor and outdoor facilities, we have a varied and extensive sports programme that offers opportunities for all to take part and succeed. High quality specialist coaching from a young age ensures that every pupil is able to develop skills and learn to value good physical health. We have an enviable record of sporting success in both local and national competitions, and an appreciation of teamwork and sportsmanship is instilled from the start.

The sports programme includes: Netball, Hockey, Cricket, Tennis, Athletics, Badminton, Basketball, Football, Tag Rugby, Swimming, Karate, Dodge Ball, Cross Country, Ball Skills, Soft Play, Yoga and Gymnastics.

Our stunning new, high-tech Music School is home to state-of-the-art facilities, including an auditorium, rehearsal studio (including an organ from Birmingham Royal Conservatoire), two music classrooms, one keyboard suite running Cubase and Sibelius workstations, percussion studio, 14 practice rooms, a music library, and instrument storage.

In addition to specialist class music lessons in our purpose built Music School from the Nursery onwards, children are able to receive individual music tuition in an orchestra of instruments including violin, viola, cello, flute, oboe, clarinet, recorder, trumpet, cornet, trombone, piano and harp. There are opportunities to play as part of a group including a junior and senior choir, harp club, wind band, string group, orchestra, hand bells, flute choir, theory classes, and much more.

Drama exists in the school in many forms – in lessons, assemblies, after-school clubs and amazing productions held either in the school hall or in the Bridge House Theatre, a fully equipped professional theatre on the adjoining campus.

There are also opportunities to learn a variety of dance styles including Ballet, Maypole dancing, Morris dancing and Irish dancing.

Extra-curricular clubs at Warwick Prep are wide ranging and meet the many interests of our pupils. The opportunity to sample an assortment of experiences not only helps our children gain a wider understanding of the world around them but enables them to specialise early if they desire.

The clubs and activities offered are provided by Warwick Prep staff and by external providers. These include Ballet, Chess, Arts Award, Karate, Irish Dancing, German Club, Rugbytots, Yoga, Maypole Dancing, Code Club, Touch Typing, Design and Technology Club, and Science Club. Our PE department provides all-encompassing training clubs in gymnastics, swimming, hockey, netball, football, cricket and mixed world sports. Our 3-18 Music department provides opportunities for children to play in various ensembles including harp, percussion, strings and brass, as well as a range of outstanding choirs.







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
